Macaroni: A tier

Extremely fun texture, works in a lot of dishes. Wholegrain macaroni is A+ tier



Gnocchi: B tier

Fills up with sauce and makes each bite extra tasty. Knocked down from A to B tier for sauce dependency



Cellentani - B tier

They've got the same spiral thing going as the macaroni but their length makes them a small downgrade in texture. Still a good pasta type



Fusili - C tier

They're pretty ordinary as far as pasta goes. Still a fine eating experience but there's nothing particularly outstanding about them



Tagliatelle - C tier

I WANT to rate this pasta higher because the nests aspect is fun, but it really isn't THAT satisfying to eat. Would still eat if served but not my first pick.



Fusilli - D tier
